zapato/zapatos

shoe/shoes

traje/trajes

jacket/jackets

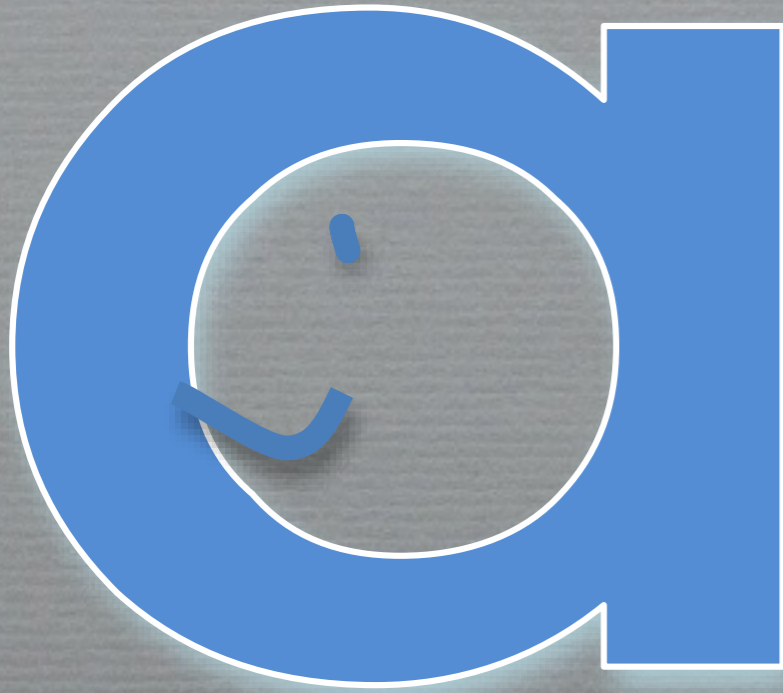
camisa/camisas

Know all 5 of these words in both the singular and plural format. I give the Spanish-you tell me what it means in English. You must give a PERFECT translation.



If a word ends in an “a” it is usually feminine.

**Examples:** la zanahoria, la berenjena and la manzana

Always look at the article! If there is an A in the article it is Feminine. If it does not have an A, it is masculine.

90% of the time if you follow this rule you will be correct!

BECAUSE sometimes there are trick words!



If a word ends in an “o” or any other letter it is usually masculine.

**Examples:** el pan, el guineo, el arroz and el cereal

**SWBAT** correctly identify Spanish words as masculine or feminine.

The article (el, la, los and las) will **always** tell you the correct gender of the word.

**Examples:**

1. La leche (Word looks masculine, but the article says the word is feminine.)
2. La moto
3. La mano
4. La foto
5. Las luces

**These are all trick words!**

These are the articles. Memorize them! I will give you Spanish you will give me the English.

**Can you tell by looking at the word what gender it is?**

**SWBAT know the Spanish articles: the, a and some.**  
**SWBAT know how to use the Spanish articles: the, a and some.**

The article (el, la, los and las) will always tell you the correct gender of the word.

Los-the (m, p)

Las-the (f, p)

Un-a (m, s)

Una-a (f, s)

Unos-some (m, p)

Unas-some (f, p)

**These are the articles and their genders!**

**S & ES**  
Vowel Consonant

You must be able to tell if the word I give you is masculine or feminine. (See slide #2)

You must also be able to tell if the article or word is singular or plural. It is best to look at the article and NOT the end of the word. If the article has an S it is plural, if it does not it is singular.
